Responses we've gotten from teachers say they make supply lists for a reason. They select the items they wish children to have based on curriculum needs and incorporate these items into lessons.

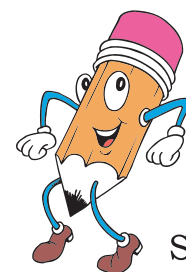
