

Melted Crayon Art

Supplies

Canvas (we used 12x12)
crayons (it took us about 36 large crayons)
hot glue
ribbon
Sharpie
Hair dryer



This one we have seen all over Pinterest in a variety of styles. We chose this one, as we liked the inspirational saying.

Sort out how you want the crayons to look. (like colors with like colors or rainbow style)
Decide what you want to write on the canvas. Do this before you hot glue the crayons to the board. Once you like what you've written, you can start to glue the markers to the board. We put a ribbon across the crayons for embellishment. Once they are secured to the board, it is time to try the hair dryer. Key here is PATIENCE! It is better to try and melt a few a time, versus going all the way down the line. You decide how much you want melted.
